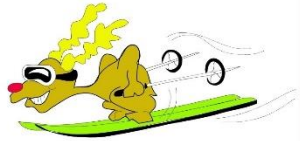

COVID 19

The present Coronavirus emergency has obliged us all to stay away from each other. For this reason the Eisteddfod committee was not able to meet as usual to arrange the next Eisteddfod's programme of competitions.

In the absence of a committee meeting, a variety of interesting ideas were brought forward by individual committee members for the 2021 Eisteddfod programme. However the Co-ordinators felt that they could not implement these proposals until they were discussed in a committee to be held to prepare for the 2022 Eisteddfod. Therefore it was decided that the programme for the 2021 Eisteddfod should remain as close as possible to the 2020 programme. Where changes were occasionally required, the opinion of the relevant judge was consulted.

The two co-ordinators therefore present the 2021 Eisteddfod Programme at an earlier time in the year. Since we are all obliged by the lockdown to stay at our homes, it was felt that this Programme would help us to occupy some of our time in a creative way. The theme is Holidays. Enjoy!

CYSTADLAETHAU CARTREF

- 1 Ni ddylai cystadlaethau dau ddimensiwn (peintio, ffotograffiaeth a chollage) ymestyn yn fwy na maint A3. Dylid rhoi teitl neu ddatganiad esboniadol i bob ymgais.
- 2 Ni ddylai gwaith 3D ymestyn yn fwy na 0.5 metr mewn unrhyw gyfeiriad (ac eithrio ffyn cerdded). Dylid rhoi teitl neu ddatganiad esboniadol i bob ymgais.
- 3 Gellir adeiladu modelau wrth raddfa o gitiau plastig (e.e. Airfix, Revel ayb.) metel, papur a choed, neu os llunnir model gwreiddiol, dylid cynnwys lluniadau wrth raddfa. Yn ddefnyddio dylid cyflwyno'r modelau mewn diorama a'u diogelu â chas arddangos. Dylent fod yn ddelweddau o wrthrychau go iawn yn hytrach na rhai ffug-wyddonol neu ffantasi. Ystyrir ansawdd y peintio ynghyd â gorffeniad y gwaith.
- 4 Dylai pob ymgeisydd osod ffugenw gwahanol ar bob ymgais o waith llenyddol unigol a gosod ffurflen gais gyflawn mewn amlen wedi ei selio a'i chyflwyno i Gydlynnydd yr Eisteddfod. Dylid nodi'r ffugenw ynghyd ag enw a rhif y gystadleuaeth ar glawr yr amlen.
- 5 Yn achos y cystadlaethau Llên, dylid amgáu amlen wedi ei hunan gyfeirio a'i stampio gyda'r ymgais os dymunir derbyn y gwaith yn ôl. Argymhella'r Pwyllgor i ymgeiswyr cystadlaethau Llên wneud a chadw copi o bob ymgais cyn ei ddanfôn trwy'r post.
- 6 Dylid cyflwyno pob cais ar gyfer cystadlu erbyn Chwefror 15^{fed} 2021, ond dylid cyflwyno'r trefniannau blodau a'r coginio yn y Neuadd erbyn 8:30 o'r gloch ar fore Gwener, Chwefror 26^{ain} 2021.
- 7 Arddangosir pob cais Celf a Chrefft yn Neuadd y Ddinas ar dydd yr Eisteddfod a'r diwrnod olynol o 10 tan 3 o'r gloch. Cesglir yr eitemau coginio ar derfyn dydd yr Eisteddfod. Dylid cysylltu â'r Cydlynnydd os na ellir casglu'r eitemau ar yr adeg yma.
- 8 Yn achos y cystadlaethau Celf a Chrefft, bydd modd casglu'r gwaith ar derfyn Dydd Sadwrn, Chwefror 27 am oddeutu 3.00 o'r gloch o'r Neuadd. Os nad yw hyn yn bosibl, gellir cysylltu â'r Cydlynnydd i drefnu amser casglu cymwys o'r Neuadd.

CYSTADLAETHAU LLWYFAN

- 9 Dylai pob ymgeisydd sy'n bwriadu cystadlu ar y llwyfan nodi hynny trwy lenwi ffurflen gais ar gyfer pob cystadleuaeth a'i hanfon ymlaen llaw at y Cydlynnydd, Mrs Glenys James, erbyn Chwefror 15^{fed} 2021. Gellir llungopio'r ffurflenni cais yn y rhaglen hon os bydd angen copïau ychwanegol.
- 10 Rhaid i'r perfformwyr yn y cystadlaethau adrodd neu gyflwyniad dramatig ddewis darn cydnabyddedig sydd wedi ei gyhoeddi.
- 11 Dylid cyflwyno 2 gopi o'r darnau adrodd a cherdd i'r Cydlynnydd erbyn Chwefror 15^{fed} 2021.
- 12 Bydd gan y beirniad yr hawl i gynnal rhagbrawf yn ystod bore'r Eisteddfod. Cynhelir hwn yn Festri Capel Seion, Stryd Newydd, Tyddewi am 8.30 y bore. Hysbysir y cystadleuwyr ymlaen llaw os digwydd hyn.
- 13 Os dymunir, gall cantorion fanteisio ar un funud yn unig i drafod gyda'r cyfeilydd cyn perfformio. Gellir canu'r emyn mewn cyweirnod o ddewis y cystadleuydd.
- 14 Bydd gan y Pwyllgor yr hawl i newid y trefniadau fel bo'r gofyn.
- 15 Bydd barn y beirniad yn derfynol ac ni chaniateir gwrthdystiad llafar ar lawr yr eisteddfod.
- 16 Rhaid i'r cystadleuwyr sicrhau fod ganddynt ganiatâd hawlfraint i berfformio eu darnau.

AMODAU CYFFREDINOL

- 17 Ni fydd Pwyllgor yr Eisteddfod yn gyfrifol am unrhyw ddamwain neu golled a all ddigwydd mewn cysylltiad â'r Eisteddfod

RULES

HOMEWORK COMPETITIONS

- 1 Two dimensional entries (photography, painting and collage) should not exceed A3 in size. Each item should be accompanied by an explanatory title or brief statement.
- 2 3D work should not exceed 0.5 metres in any direction (with the exception of walking sticks). Each item should be accompanied by a brief explanatory title or statement.
- 3 Scale models may be constructed from plastic (e.g. Airfix, Revel etc.), metal, paper and wood kits, or, if of original design to be supported by 3 view scale diagrams. Ideally they should be presented within a diorama and protected by a display case. They should be representations of real subjects and not science fiction or fantasy designs. Quality of finish and paintwork will be considered.
- 4 Competitors should attach a different *nom de plume* to each literary entry and enclose a completed entry form in a sealed envelope to be submitted to the Eisteddfod Co-ordinator. The *nom de plume*, competition name and number should be placed on the envelope cover.
- 5 In the case of the literary competitions, a self-addressed, stamped envelope should be included with the entry if the work is to be returned. The Committee strongly recommends that a copy of all written work is made and retained by the competitor before posting it.
- 6 Each entry should be submitted by February 15th 2021, but the flower arrangements and cookery should be submitted in the City Hall at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, February 26th 2021.
- 7 All art and craft entries will be exhibited in the City Hall during the Eisteddfod day and on the following day from 10 to 3 pm. Cookery entries to be collected at the end of the Eisteddfod day. Contact the Co-ordinator if you are unable to collect these items at the arranged time.
- 8 In the case of the Art and Craft entries, work may be collected at the end of Saturday, February 27th at about 3.00pm. from the Hall. If this is not possible, then please contact the Co-ordinator to arrange an appropriate collection time.

STAGE COMPETITIONS

- 9 Each competitor who wishes to compete on stage should complete an entry form and submit it to the Co-ordinator, Mrs Glenys James by February 15th 2021. Further copies of the entry form may be photocopied from the examples in this programme if required.
- 10 Competitors in the recitation or dramatic presentation competitions are required to choose a published poem.
- 11 2 copies of the recitation and music to be submitted to the Co-ordinator by February 15th 2021.
- 12 The adjudicators reserve the right to hold preliminary competitions during the morning of the Eisteddfod. These will be held at Seion Chapel Vestry, New Street, St Davids at 8.30 a.m. Competitors will be notified before hand if this occurs.
- 13 If required, competitors may confer with the accompanist for one minute only before their performance. Hymn singing competitors may choose a suitable key.
- 14 The Committee reserves the right to change the arrangements as required.
- 15 The adjudicator's decision will be final & verbal protests during the Eisteddfod will not be permitted.
- 16 Competitors are required to ensure that they have copyright permission to perform their pieces.

GENERAL RULES

- 17 The Eisteddfod Committee will not be liable for any accident or loss sustained in connection with the Eisteddfod.
